Chapter 38

- (1) And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- (2) Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him,
- (3) And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I *am* against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:
- (4) And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts of armor, even a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:
- (5) Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them; all of them with shield and helmet:
- (6) Gomer, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his bands: *and* many people with thee.
- (7) Be thou prepared, and prepare for thyself, thou, and all thy company that are assembled unto thee, and be thou a guard unto them.

- (5) Persia^b, Ethiopia^c, and Libya^d with them; all of them with shield and helmet:
- (6) Gomer^e, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah^f of the north quarters, and all his bands: *and* many people with you.

38:1a-Gog, Magog, Rosh, Meshech, Tubal all refer to areas within Russia.

Rosh -- may be root name of Russia; Meshech -- believed to be the city of Moscow

- (9) Thou shalt ascend and come like a storm, thou shalt be like a cloud to cover the land, thou, and all thy bands, and many people with thee.
- (10) Thus saith the Lord GOD; It shall also come to pass, *that* at the same time shall things come into thy mind, and thou shalt think an evil thought:

- (9) You shall ascend and come like a storm, you shall be like a cloud to cover the land, you, and all your bands, and many people with you.
- (10) This is what the Lord GOD {Jehovah} says; It shall also come to pass, *that* at the same time things shall come into your mind, and you shall think an evil thought:
- (11) And you shall say, I will go up to the land of unwalled villages; I will go to those who are at rest, who live safely, all of them living without walls, and having neither bars nor gates,
- (12) To take a spoil, and to take a prey; to turn your hand upon the desolate places *that* are now inhabited, and upon the people who are gathered out of the nations, who have obtained cattle and goods, who live in the midst of the land.

- (14) Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say unto Gog, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In that day when my people of Israel dwelleth safely, shalt thou not know *it*?
- (15) And thou shalt come from thy place out of the north parts, thou, and many people with thee, all of them riding upon horses, a great company, and a mighty army:
- (16) And thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; it shall be in the latter days, and I will bring thee against my land, that the heathen may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes.

- (4) Thou shalt fall upon the mountains of Israel, thou, and all thy bands, and the people that *is* with thee: I will give thee unto the ravenous birds of every sort, and *to* the beasts of the field to be devoured.

- (21) And I will call for a sword against him throughout all My mountains, says the Lord GOD {Jehovah}: every man's sword shall be against his brother.

Chapter 39

- (2) And I will turn you back, and leave only the sixth part of you, and will cause you to come up from the northern parts, and will bring you upon the mountains of Israel:
- (3) And I will strike your bow from your left hand, and will cause your arrows to fall from your right hand.
- (4) You shall fall upon the mountains of Israel, you, and all your bands, and the people who *are* with you: I will give you to the ravenous birds of every sort, and *to* the beasts of the field to be devoured.

- (5) Thou shalt fall upon the open field: for I have spoken *it*, saith the Lord GOD.
- (6) And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- (7) So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not *let them* pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that I *am* the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.
- (8) Behold, it is come, and it is done, saith the Lord GOD; this *is* the day whereof I have spoken.
- (9) And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:

- (7) So I will make My holy Name known in the midst of My people Israel; and I will not *let them* pollute My holy Name any more: and the ungodly nations shall know that I *am* the LORD {Jehovah}, the Holy One in Israel.
- (8) Look, it has come, and it is done, says the Lord GOD {Jehovah}; this *is* the day of which I have spoken.
- (9) And those who live in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the clubs, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:

- 39:6b send Note: when God "sends" it usually is by a human agent God "sent" Nebuchadnezzar to destroy Israel – a nuclear exchange between the US and Russia is a possibility
- 39:6c "carelessly in the isles" we are not told in scripture where the "isles" are, but could be a possible reference to the Americas.
- 39:11d Hamon-gog {המון גוג} "the multitudes of Gog"

- (12) And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land.
- (13) Yea, all the people of the land shall bury *them*; and it shall be to them a renown the day that I shall be glorified, saith the Lord GOD.
- (14) And they shall sever out men of continual employment, passing through the land to bury with the passengers those that remain upon the face of the earth, to cleanse it: after the end of seven months shall they search.

- (2) In the visions of God brought he me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a very high mountain, by which *was* as the frame of a city on the south.
- (3) And he brought me thither, and, behold, there was a man, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

- (28) Then they shall know that I am the LORD {Jehovah} their God, Who caused them to be led into captivity among the ungodly nations: but I have gathered them to their own land, and have left none of them there any more.
- (29) Neither will I hide My face any more from them: because I have poured out My Spirit upon the house of Israel, says the Lord GOD {Jehovah}.

Chapter 40

- (1) In the twenty-fifth year* of our captivity, in the beginning of the year, in the tenth *day* of the month, in the fourteenth year after the city was destroyed^a, on that very day the hand of the LORD {Jehovah} was upon me, and brought me there.
- (2) In the visions of God He brought me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a very high mountain, by which the frame of a city *was* on the south.
- (3) And He brought me there, and, look, there was a man, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

40:1a - 25th year of Ezekiel's {and Jehoiachin's} captivity was the 14th year after the city of Jerusalem was destroyed. This means that the city {and the temple} was destroyed 19 years after the first captivity {that of Daniel and his friends} and the 11th year of Ezekiel's captivity. Appendix B A Comparison of Gog's Invasion In Ezekiel 38-39 and Revelation 20

In Ezekiel the invasion is in the last years {Ezek. 38:8} In the Revelation the invasion is after the millennium {Rev. 20:6}

In Ezekiel the invasion takes place on the mountains of Israel {Ezek. 38:8} In the Revelation the invasion is around Jerusalem {Rev. 20:9}

In Ezekiel the purpose of the invasion is to take spoil {Ezek. 38:8} In the Revelation the purpose is to overthrow Jesus {Rev. 20:9}

In Ezekiel there is a list of the Soviet allies who will come accompany Gog and a list of those who will not be involved. {Ezek. 38:13} In the Revelation all nations will be involved {Rev. 20:8}

In Ezekiel the invasion is followed by the new temple {Ezek. 40} In the Revelation the invasion is followed by the Great Judgment and the creation of the new heavens and new earth.

In Ezekiel it will take seven years to clean up the dead bodies and weapons of war {Ezek. 39:9} In the Revelation clean up isn't necessary because there will be a new heavens and new earth.

In Ezekiel the Lord will be made known to the nations {Ezek. 38:23} In the Revelation the Lord has already reigned upon the entire earth for 1000 years so everyone already knows Him.

Conclusion: the two invasions cannot possibly be the same invasion.
