# Chapter 7

- (1) In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, *and* told the sum of the matters.
- (2) Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.
- (3) And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another.
- (4) The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- (5) And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and *it had* three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.
- (6) After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it.
- (7) After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.

## Chapter 7

- (1) In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon\*<sup>a</sup> Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, *and* told the sum of the matters.
- (2) Daniel spoke and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, look, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.
- (3) And four great beasts came up from the sea, different from one another.
- (4) The first was like a lion<sup>b</sup>, and had eagle's wings: I watched until its wings were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made to stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- (5) And look another beast, a second, like a bear<sup>c</sup>, and it raised up itself on one side, and *it had* three ribs in its mouth between its teeth: and they said this to it, Arise, devour much flesh.
- (6) After this I saw, and another, like a leopard<sup>d</sup>, which had upon its back four wings of a bird; the beast also had four heads; and authority to rule was given to it.
- (7) After this I saw in the night visions, and look a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and exceedingly strong; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and broke in pieces, and stamped the residue with its feet: and it was different from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.
