(17) And He carrying His cross went forth into a place called *the place* of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha:

(18) Where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the middle.^c

(19) And Pilate wrote a title, and put *it* on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.^d

(20) This title then was read by many of the Jews: because the place where Jesus was crucified was near to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, *and* Greek, *and* Latin.

(21) Then the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, Do not write, The King of the Jews; but that He said, I am King of the Jews.

(22) Pilate answered, What I have written I have written.

(23) Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His clothing, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also *His* coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

(24) They said therefore among themselves, Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which says,

**They parted My clothing among
them, and for My coat they
cast lots.^e**

These things therefore the soldiers did.

(25) Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the *wife* of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene.

(26) When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple standing by, whom He loved,^f He said to His mother, **Woman, see your son!**

(27) Then He said to the disciple, **See your mother!** And from that hour that disciple took her to his own *home*.

(28) After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, said,

I thirst.^g

(29) Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put *it* upon hyssop, and put *it* to His mouth.

(30) When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, **It is finished:**^h and He bowed His head, and gave up the spirit {Nisan 14; Mar.-Apr.} {1/14/4071 A.H./C-29 A.D.}.
