- (16) Let no man therefore judge you in food, or in drink, or in respect to a holy day, or of the new moons, or of the sabbath *days* {Saturdays}:
- (17) Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.
- (18) Let no man deceive you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshiping of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen,^a vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,
- (19) And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increases with the increase of God.
- (20) Since you are dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are you subject to laws,
- (21) (Touch not; taste not; handle not;
- (22) Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and teachings of men?
- (23) Those things indeed have a show of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honor to the satisfying of the flesh.
