- (13) But I would not have you to be ignorant, brothers, concerning those who are asleep, that you not sorrow, even as others who have no hope.
- (14) Because if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so those also who sleep in Jesus God will bring with Him.
- (15) Because this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive *and* remain to the coming of the Lord shall not precede those who are asleep.
- (16) Because the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:^d
- (17) Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be caught upe together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
- (18) Therefore comfort one another with these words.
