{28} Hosea

- (10) I will be your King: where in all your cities *is any other* who may save you? and your judges of whom you said, Give me a king and princes?
- (11) I gave you a king in My anger, and took *him* away in My wrath {anger; judgment}.
- (12) The evil of Ephraim *is* bound up; his sin *is* hidden.
- (13) The sorrows of a woman in child birth shall come upon him: he *is* an unwise son; because he should not stay long in *the place of* the birth of children.
- (14) I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be your plagues; O grave, I will be your destruction: repentance will be hidden from My eyes.
- (15) Though he is fruitful among his brothers, an east wind will come, the wind of the LORD {Jehovah} will come up from the wilderness, and his spring will become dry, and his fountain will be dried up: he will spoil the treasure of all pleasant vessels.
- (16) Samaria will become desolate; because she has rebelled against her God: they will fall by the sword: their infants will be dashed in pieces, and their pregnant women will be ripped up.

Chapter 14

(1) O Israel, return to the LORD {Jehovah} your God; because you have fallen because of your evil deeds.

- (2) Take with you words, and turn to the LORD {Jehovah}: say to Him, Take away all evil, and receive *us* graciously: so we will give the calves {sacrifices} of our lips {praise}.
- (3) Asshur will not save us; we will not ride upon horses: neither will we say any more to the work of our hands, *You are* our gods: because in You the fatherless find mercy.
- (4) I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: because My anger is turned away from him.
- (5) I will be as the dew to Israel: he will grow as the lily, and cast forth his roots as Lebanon.
- (6) His branches will spread, and his beauty will be as the olive tree, and his smell as Lebanon.
- (7) Those who live under His shadow will return; they will revive *as* the corn, and grow as the vine: its scent *will be* as the wine of Lebanon.
- (8) Ephraim *will say*, What have I to do any more with idols? I have heard *him*, and observed him: I *am* like a green fir tree. From Me your fruit is found.
- (9) Who is wise, and he will understand these *things?* prudent, and he will know them? because the ways of the LORD {Jehovah} *are* right, and the just will walk in them: but the sinners will fall in them.
