Session 9: Jan. 29, 2023 John 7:14-29 He Sent Me

- (4) Because *there is* no man *who* does anything in secret, if he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world.
- (5) Because neither did His brothers believe in Him.
- (6) Then Jesus said to them, My time has not yet come: but your time is always ready.
- (7) The world cannot hate you; but Me it hates, because I testify of it, that its works are evil.
- (8) You go up to this feast: I am not yet^b going up to this feast; because My time has not yet fully come.
- (9) When He had said these words to them, He remained *still* in Galilee.
- (10) But when His brothers had left, then He also went up to the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.
- (11) Then the Jews sought Him at the feast, and said, Where is He?
- (12) And there was much murmuring among the people concerning Him: because some said, He is a good man: others said, No; but He deceives the people.
- (13) Nevertheless no man spoke openly about Him for fear of the Jews.

- (14) Now about the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.
- (15) And the Jews marveled, saying, How does this Man know letters, having never been educated?
- (16) Jesus answered them, and said, My teaching is not Mine, but His Who sent Me.
- (17) If any man will do His will, he shall know of the teaching, whether it is of God, or *whether* I speak of Myself.
- (18) He who speaks of himself seeks his own glory: but He who seeks the glory of Him Who sent Him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.

- (19) Did not Moses give you the law, and *yet* none of you keeps the law? Why do you go about to kill Me?
- (20) The people answered and said, You have a demon: Who seeks to kill You?
- (21) Jesus answered and said to them, I have done one work, and you all marvel.
- (22) Moses therefore gave to you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the forefathers;) and you on the sabbath day {Saturday} circumcise a man.
- (23) If a man on the sabbath {Saturday} receives circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are you angry at Me, because I have made a man in every way whole on the sabbath {Saturday}?
- (24) Do not judge according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.
- (25) Then some of those from Jerusalem said, Is not this He, Whom they seek to kill?
- (26) But, look, He speaks boldly, and they say nothing to Him. Do the rulers know indeed that this is the very Christ?
- (27) How is it we know where this man is from: but when Christ comes, no man knows where He is from.
- (28) Then Jesus cried out in the temple as He taught, saying, You both know Me, and you know where I am from: and I have not come on My own, but He Who sent Me is true, Whom you do not know.
- (29) But I know Him: because I am from Him, and He has sent Me.

- (30) Then they sought to take Him: but no man laid hands on Him, because His hour had not yet come.
- (31) And many of the people believed on Him, and said, When Christ comes, will He do more miracles than these which this *Man* has done?

- (32) The Pharisees heard that the people murmured such things concerning Him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take Him.
- (33) Then Jesus said to them, Yet for a little while I am with you, and *then* I go to Him Who sent Me.
- (34) You shall seek Me, and shall not find *Me*: and where I am, *there* you cannot come.
- (35) Then the Jews said among themselves, Where will He go, that we shall not find Him? will He go to the dispersed among the Gentiles {non-Jews}, and teach the Gentiles {non-Jews}?
- (36) What *manner of* saying is this that He said, Ye shall seek Me, and shall not find *Me*: and where I am, *there* you cannot come?
- (37) In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come to Me, and drink.
- (38) He who believes on Me, as the scripture has said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.^c
- (39) (But this He spoke of the Spirit, which those who believe on Him would receive: because the Holy Spirit had not yet been *given*; because Jesus was not yet glorified.)
- (40) Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, Truly this is the Prophet.^d
