Session 13: May 28, 2023 John 21:15-23 Do You Love Me?

- (13) Jesus then came, and took bread, and gave it to them, and fish likewise.
- (14) This is now the third time that Jesus showed Himself to His disciples, after He had risen from the dead.

>>>>

- (15) So when they had dined, Jesus said to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, do you love Me more than these? He said to Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I love You. He said to him, Feed My lambs.
- (16) He said to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, do you love^e Me? He said to Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I love^f You. He said to him, Feed My sheep.
- (17) He said to him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, do you love^e Me? Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, Do you love^e Me? And he said to him, Lord, You know all things; You know that I love^f You. Jesus said to him, Feed My sheep.
- (18) Truly, truly, I say to you, When you were young, you clothed yourself, and walked wherever you wanted: but when you are old, you shall stretch forth your hands, and another shall lead you, and carry *you* where you do not want to go.
- (19) This He spoke, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, Follow Me.
- (20) Then Peter, turning about, seeing the disciple whom Jesus loved^g following; who also leaned on His breast at supper, and said, Lord, who is he who betrays You?
- (21) Peter seeing him said to Jesus, Lord, and what *shall* this man *do?*
- (22) Jesus said to him, If I will that he stays until I come, what *is* that to you? You follow Me.

- (23) Then this saying went abroad among the brothers, that that disciple would not die: but Jesus did not say to him, He shall not die; but, If I will that he stays until I come, what *is that* to you?
- (24) This is the disciple who testifies of these things, and wrote these things: and we know that his testimony is true.
- (25) And there are also many other things which Jesus did, which, if every one of them should be written, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen {let it be}.
