## Session 1: Sept. 3, 2023 Mk. 1:1-13 Introduced

## Chapter 1

>>>>>>

- (1) The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;
- (2) As it is written in the prophets,<sup>a</sup>

Look, I send My messenger before Your face, who shall prepare Your way before You.<sup>b</sup>

- (3) The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare the way of the LORD {Jehovah}, make His paths straight.<sup>c</sup>
- (4) John baptized in the wilderness, and preached the baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.
- (5) And all the land of Judea went out to him, and those of Jerusalem, and were all baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins.
- (6) And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a belt of a leather around his waist; d and he ate locusts and wild honey;
- (7) And preached, saying, There comes One mightier than I after me, the latchet of Whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.
- (8) I indeed have baptized you with water: but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.
- (9) And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized by John in the Jordan River.
- (10) And immediately coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon Him:
- (11) And there came a voice from heaven, *saying*, You are My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.<sup>e</sup>
- (12) And immediately the Spirit drove Him into the wilderness.

(13) And He was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted by Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered to Him.

- (14) Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,
- (15) And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent, and believe the gospel.<sup>f</sup>
- (16) Now as He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: because they were fishermen.<sup>g</sup>
- (17) And Jesus said to them, Come follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.
