{41} Mark

- (10) Because He had healed many; many who had diseases pressed upon Him in order to touch Him.
- (11) And unclean spirits, when they saw Him, fell down before Him, and cried, saying, You are the Son of God.
- (12) And He strictly charged them that they should not make Him known.
- (13) And He went up into a mountain, and called *to Himself* whomever He wanted: and they came to Him.
- (14) And He ordained twelve,^c that they should be with Him, and that He might send them forth to preach,
- (15) And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out demons:
- (16) And Simon He surnamed Peter;
- (17) And James the *son* of Zebedee, and John the brother of James; and He surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder:
- (18) And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the *son* of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,
- (19) And Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him: and they went into a house.
- (20) And the multitude came together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread.
- (21) And when His friends heard *of it,* they went out to lay hold on Him: because they said, He is beside Himself.

- (22) And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, He has Beelzebub,^d and by the prince of the demons He casts out demons.
- (23) And He called them to Himself, and said to them in parables, How can Satan cast out Satan?
- (24) And if a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand.
- (25) And if a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand.
- (26) And if Satan rises up against himself, and is divided, he cannot stand, but has an end.
- (27) No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, unless he first binds the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- (28) Truly I say to you, All sins shall be forgiven the sons of men, and blasphemies with which they shall blaspheme:
- (29) But he who shall blaspheme against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:
- (30) Because they said, He has an unclean spirit.
- (31) Then His brothers and His mother came, and, standing outside, sent to Him, calling Him.^g
- (32) And the multitude sat around Him, and they said to Him, Look, Your mother and Your brothers are outside seeking You.
